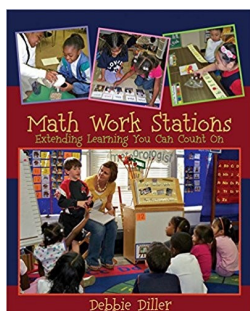


Debbie Diller
